Please be sure to comply with all course prerequisites prior to attending the 8-hour in-classroom course.


The BLS Instructor Course does not teach BLS Provider skills. This course teaches BLS Instructor skills.

	A printed copy of the Instructor Candidate Workbook

* Your BLS Provider card must be issued from the AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION. No other certificates will be accepted. See samples below.
